CFUW Charitable Trust

CFUW has supported graduate study, literacy and creative arts through awards and fellowships since its founding in 1919. In 1921 the 12 Clubs of the federation awarded the first CFUW Fellowship of \$1000. In 1967 the CFUW Charitable Trust was established as a separate entity as a way of fulfilling CFUW's commitment to the advancement of women through education, to receive donations, and manage the resulting funds to provide CFUW Fellowships and Awards.

The CFUW Charitable Trust assists women university graduates - the future of our country - to further their post-secondary education. The Trust raises money to support annual Fellowships, Awards and Grants for Canadian women doing advanced graduate study and research in science, math, engineering, home economics, education, visual arts, music, humanities, and social sciences. Currently the Charitable Trust manages a substantial fund of over \$2m that is used to fund over \$90k in awards for incredibly talented women who are pursuing graduate studies. Our commitment to Education has not wavered since 1919!
